## SPITFIRE TRAILER WARRANTY

All Spitfire Trailers are covered by Warranty for 12 months from the date of purchase. The chassis is warranted for 2 years.

The Warranty period starts on the date the trailer is first delivered.

## Warranties apply for

- Spitfire parts and labour
- External items purchased by Spitfire for fitting to a trailer, if warranted by that supplier
- Licenced use of the trailer for the intended purpose, and in compliance with the rated ATM

## Warranty is not provided for

- Wear and tear through normal use, and in particular for items such as tyres, brake linings, wheel bearings, seals, and wear surfaces
- Damage due to or caused by:
  - Negligence and misuse
  - o Rough/4WD track use
  - o Accessories fitted by others
  - o Non-approved chassis or frame modifications, or additions

## Other Warranty conditions and notes:

Warranty is provided by the Dealer responsible for trailer manufacture and therefore, for any repair type Warranty, the trailer needs to be returned to the Dealer's workshop or trailer place of purchase. Freight or courier charges incurred to provide and support any Warranty will be to the trailer owner's account.

All Spitfire trailer models are certified by independent vehicle engineering companies to meet or exceed the Motor Vehicle Act 1989 and VSB 1 design rules for light trailers. For this reason, any modification, design change, or addition to the original will void manufactures warranty unless approved in writing by the Spitfire manufacturer.

Our Warranty is transferable to subsequent purchasers within the original time frames.

All remedies under warranty will be limited to a once only replacement or repair of the original part or component. Any other remedy or substitution shall be at the discretion of the Spitfire Dealer.

Spare parts are carried across our Dealer network, including bearings and seals which are also commercially available elsewhere if preferred.
